It is being commercially cultivated mainly in Nilgiri and Kodaikanal hills of Tamil Nadu and around Bangalore in Karnataka.

Botanical Name: Pelargonium graveolens

Family: Geraniaceae

Plant Discription:

It is a bushy aromatic herb. Stem is cylindrical, woody at base. Pubescent, green when young and turning brown with age Leaves are alternate, stipulate, simple with about 5 palmatisect primary lobes and pinnatisect secondary lobes, pubescent on both lobes. Flowers are pentamerous, bisexual with pink corolla.
