Carrot Irrigation

Irrigation is given immediately after sowing. The irrigation cycle depends upon season, type of soil and amount of organic matter present in soil. Depending upon the planting season and the available soil moisture, carrots may be irrigated at 10-12 days interval during winter and 5-6 days interval during summer. Irrigation should be discontinued 2-3 weeks before harvesting to increase the sweetness and taste of the carrots.
