Radish Harvesting

The edible roots become ready for harvesting in about 25-60 days depending on the variety. The temperate types reach harvest maturity 25-30 days after seed sowing while tropical varieties require longer period. At the time of harvest, the roots should not be pithy or solid.

Crop is harvested manually by uprooting individual plant. A light irrigation may be given a day before harvesting to facilitate lifting of roots.

Yield

The average yield of Asiatic cultivars ranged between 25-35 t/ha in 40-60 days while the temperate varieties yield 15-20 t/ha in 35-40 days.
