Intercultural Operations

Intercultural operations like weeding and hoeing are necessary to check the weed growth and provide soil aeration for better growth and yield.

During rainy season, two weeding are required to keep the growth of weeds under check. In radish, the growing roots tend to push out of the soil surface. Therefore, earthing up and weeding during the early stages of growth are necessary for proper development of quality roots.
