#### **Eligibility Criteria**

Officers below the age of 65 years having Ph.D. Degree Agriculture/Horticulture or related life sciences discipline with research area in Plant Pathology/Plant Virology, an expert Plant Pathologist with specialization in Plant Virology and working experience of more than 15 years in modern virus diagnostic tools (preferably nucleic acid and HTS-based virome) and cleaning of viruses from plants as evident from high quality publications. The applicant should also have 10 years of experience in of plant certification execution programme of horticultural crops at National level and should be well versed with the functioning of ICAR organization and its Institutes.

#### Job Profile

Responsibility to coordinate capacity building, communication, and management activities related to the Clean Plant Program The role involves facilitating collaboration among government agencies, researchers, and industry stakeholders through regular meetings, producing and disseminating visual and written materials, managing data and information, and drafting notifications for the Seed Act and Model Nursery Registration Act. Responsibilities also include coordinating Clean Plant Centre (CPC) management by reviewing annual work plans and SOPs, overseeing the clean plant certification system through certification framework development and nursery inspection training, and preparing technical reports for submission.

# **Technical Head CPP Wing - NHB**

## I. Objective and Background of the Assignment

Horticultural crops are vital for India's food and nutritional security. Horticulture is a major income source and employment opportunities for the farming communities, particularly for women, and diversifies their income. The cultivation of fruit and nut trees is one the major components of horticulture. The planting material plays a vital role in growth and productivity of fruit and nut trees. Infection of non-curable viruses and virus-like pathogens (viruses, virioids etc.) which are vegetatively propagated poses a major challenge in realising the production potential of clonally propagated horticultural crops. This along with the issue of lack of healthy and reliable plant material is one of major constraints in production, productivity and profitability of these crops.

To bridge the constraint, Govt of India has launched 'Clean Plant Program (CPP)' for production of clean planting material in important fruit and nut crops to be implemented by Department of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare, Government of India, National Horticulture Board (NHB) and Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). The CPP Wing of NHB will serve as CPP's Project Management Unit.

The objective of this assignment is to coordinate the capacity building and communication unit, clean plant centre management unit and clean plant certifications scheme unit for effective implementation of Clean Plant Programme at CPP Wing of NHB.

#### II. Scope of Work

Technical Head will be based at the CPP Wing of National Horticulture Board, Gurugram, Haryana, India and work for the implementation of technical programme by coordinating different units of CPP Wing at NHB viz. the capacity building and communication unit, clean plant centre management unit and clean plant certifications scheme unit.

Technical Head will work in coordinating the technical implementation of the India's Clean Plant Programme in close association with EAs and IAs.

#### III. Key Responsibilities

The Technical Head CPP Wing - NHB will perform the following tasks:

#### 1. Coordinating capacity building and communication

- Coordination among the government, researchers, and nursery/industry/growers by arranging and coordinating regular and ad-hoc meetings
- Production of visual and written materials and their dissemination to the stakeholders
- Management of data and information related with CPP
- Preparation of draft notifications to the seed act and model nursery registration act
- Preparation of training and research programs

#### 2. Coordination of Clean Plant Centre Management

- Reviewing of annual work plan/activities of CPCs
- SOPs of Clean Plant Centres

#### 3. Coordinating clean plant certification system

- Preparing certification system at different levels
- Training programme for inspection of nurseries

- ii. The applicant should also have 10 years of experience in execution of plant certification programme of horticultural crops at National level and should be well versed with the functioning of ICAR organization and its Institutes.
- iii. The applicant should have experience in policy planning in the area of plant certification programme of horticultural crops at national level as evident from his involvement in implementation of such programmes.
- iv. The applicant should be able to attend office regularly at the NHB Office located at Gurugram, Haryana and ready to travel across India for implementation and operation of Clean Plant Programme and Clean Plant Centres under it.
