At the outset, the Managing Director of NHB, as Chairman of the Project Appraisal Committee (PAC), welcomed all members and officials present. He addressed the participants and provided a brief overview of the evaluation criteria and timelines laid out in the guidelines, which form the basis for evaluating the proposals. He recalled the discussions and decisions taken in the previous PAC meeting, particularly with regard to the evaluation of concept notes received under the High-Value Multi-Commodity Clusters and Peri-Urban Vegetable Clusters. The Chairman noted that 53 applications were received in the 2nd EoI out of which 14 were shortlisted, 2 were non-shortlisted and 37 were asked to re-submit their concept notes in line with the CDP guidelines.

He further highlighted that the purpose of the present meeting was to review the revised submissions received during the given window, assess their conformity with the scheme guidelines, and take a view on their shortlisting. Shri Pawan Kumar, DD, NHB and representative of the PMU, thereafter presented the status of the resubmitted proposals, along with responsiveness checks, for the consideration of the PAC.

1. M/s Punjab Agro Exports Corporation Ltd. (PAGREXCO) - (Consortium of Private Limited Companies) - 03ACDP000133

The applicant M/s Punjab Agro Exports Corporation Ltd. is a Private Limited Company. The applicant has applied in a consortium with M/s Punjab Agro Industries Corporation Limited (PAIC). The applicant has experience in operating Fruit & Vegetable (F&V) processing plants along with selling/purchasing, importing, exporting, storing, preserving & distribution of fresh and processed Agri products. For FY 2023-24 the consortium's turnover is INR 17,015.71 Lakhs and net worth is INR 11,577.19 Lakhs. The applicant has submitted a concept note to set up a Multi Commodity High Value Cluster with Kinnow as focus crop under the proposed cluster.

The PAC has discussed the proposal in detail in the light of scheme guideline and observed that the applicant fulfilled all legal and financial criteria, including equity and net worth, and provided a clean financial declaration. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 38.5 out of 50. It was decided that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR / business case.

2. M/s Shree Paramanand Rural Development Society (Consortium of NGO and Private Limited Companies) - 29ACDP000106

The applicant M/s Shree Paramanand Rural Development Society is a registered NGO. The applicant has applied in a consortium with M/s LTGL Agro Industries Private Limited, M/s LTG Mysore Greens Exports Private Limited, M/s LTG Infrastructure Limited and M/s Indian Organic Fertilizers. The applicant has experience in experienced in FPO formation, organic farming projects, and brand promotion for rural produce. For FY 2023-24 the consortium's turnover is INR 7,954.13 Lakhs and net worth is INR 3,734.12 Lakhs. The applicant has submitted a concept note to set up a Multi Commodity High Value Cluster with Grapes as focus crop in Karnataka.

The PAC has discussed the proposal in detail in the light of scheme guideline and observed that the applicant fulfilled all legal and financial criteria, including equity and net worth, and provided a clean financial declaration. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 36.5 out of 50. It was decided by the committee that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR / business.

3. M/s Shreekrishna Impex Ventures Limited (Consortium of Private Limited Companies) - 23ACDP000105

The applicant M/s Shreekrishna Impex Ventures Limited is a Private Limited Company. The applicant has applied in a consortium with M/s Shreekrishna Foodtek Private Limited. The applicant has experience in Indian banana export industry and work with farmer network of over 20,000 farmers. For FY 2023-24 the consortium's turnover is INR 33,273.20 Lakhs and net worth for FY 2024-25 is INR 1,506.43 Lakhs. The applicant has submitted a concept note to set up a Multi Commodity High Value Cluster with Banana as focus crop in Andhra Pradesh.

The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 32 out of 50. It was decided by the committee that the proposal be shortlisted for submission of DPR / business case.

5. M/s Fresh Cart Agro Pvt. Ltd. (Consortium of Private Limited Companies) - 28ACDP000151

The applicant M/s Fresh Cart Agro Pvt. Ltd. is a Private Limited Company. The applicant has applied in a consortium with M/s Bandhan Agri Tech Private Limited. The applicant has a experience in the banana supply chain ecosystem and B2B supplier of premium Fresh Fruits and Vegetables to leading retail chains in Bangalore, including Aditya Birla More, JioMart, Zepto, Swiggy Instamart, and Big Basket. For FY 2023-24 the applicant's turnover is INR 8899.27 Lakhs and net worth is INR 254.32 Lakhs. The applicant has submitted a concept note to set up a Multi Commodity High Value Cluster with banana as focus crop in Andhra Pradesh.

The PAC has discussed the proposal in detail in the light of scheme guideline and observed that the applicant fulfilled all legal and financial criteria, including equity and net worth, and provided a clean financial declaration. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 33.5 out of 50. It was decided by the committee that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR / business case.

The applicant has submitted a concept note to set up a Multi Commodity High Value Cluster with cocoa as focus crop in Andhra Pradesh.

The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 31 out of 50. It was decided by the committee that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR / business case.

8. M/s Panchaganga Seeds Private Limited (Private Limited Company) - 27ACDP000109

The applicant M/s Panchaganga Seeds Private Limited is a Private Limited Company. The applicant has submitted a concept note to set up a Peri Urban Vegetable Cluster with Tomato, Potato, Onion, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Okra, Brinjals, Capsicum, Beans, Drumsticks, Radish, Carrot, Amaranthus, Fenugreek, Bell Peppers, Broccoli, Zucchini, Lettuce, English Cucumber, and Cherry Tomatoes as targeted crop in Telangana.

The PAC has discussed the proposal in detail in the light of scheme guideline and observed that the applicant fulfilled all legal and financial criteria, including equity and net worth, and provided a clean financial declaration. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 31 out of 50. It was decided by the committee that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR / business case.

The applicant M/s Pawana Sanskruti Farmer Producer Company Limited is a Farmer Producer Company and has the application in consortium with M/s Stately Agro Industries Private Limited and M/s Prometteur Solutions Private Limited. The applicant has experience in the collective cultivation, aggregation, and export of high-quality roses. They have a robust membership of 411 farmer stakeholders. For FY 2023-24 the applicant's turnover is INR 1021.66 Lakhs and net worth for FY 2024 -25 is INR 98.94 Lakhs. The applicant has submitted a concept note to set up a Multi Commodity High Value Cluster with rose as focus crop in Maharashtra.

The PAC has discussed the proposal in detail in the light of scheme guideline and observed that the applicant fulfilled all legal and financial criteria, including equity and net worth, and provided a clean financial declaration. The proposal was technically evaluated and scored 32.5 out of 50. It was decided by the committee that the proposal may be shortlisted for submission of DPR / business case.

Advisory note:

The PAC re-emphasised that the subsidy component towards the IA component is a back-ended credit linked subsidy which will be paid out in three tranches as detailed in the scheme guidelines. The initial payments (i.e., provision for bridge finance / working capital) of the IA component shall be made by the IA, in line with clause 9.4.12.



The committee also briefly discussed other proposals that were non-shortlisted since they were found to not meet the eligibility, technical and financial criteria. The case wise decision of the PAC is presented in the table below:
